("Let's go" plays—Barbara enters with yardstick taped on her shoulders and measuring tape around her neck and with tape measures on either side of pants—walks down runway, pauses, twirls, and then goes to stage)

Talk about accessorizing: don't the tape measures just set it off? How about a nice round of applause for this piece and our supermodel Beautiful Barbara B.?

3. ANNOUNCER: How many of us got cold feet when it came to working the 5th Step? Come on put your hands up! Wouldn't it have been so helpful if our very attire helped us to get past this difficult step? Okay, well help is on the way! Next up is the 5th Step Fashion Ensemble!

("Pink Panther" music plays—Jim enters with binoculars and trash bags attached to clothes- walks down runway, pauses, twirls, and then goes to stage)

Note the sturdy binoculars that come with this piece. That's to symbolize the searching and fearless moral inventory we do in the previous step which leads right into this one. Also note the durable and stylish deep pockets on either leg. In the Big Book about step 5 it says that we "pocket our pride and go to it" well, these are pride pockets. And to get rid off all that excess

baggage you've been carrying around for years, the charming underarm frills double as trash bags. Let's hear it for the 5th Step Fashion Ensemble and our supermodel Gentleman Jim J.!

("Love in an elevator" plays—Ken enters wearing his jumpsuit-- walks down runway, pauses, twirls, and then goes to stage)

But for our purposes it won't open because number one, union rules don't permit it and number two, the elevator is broken so take the steps. ("These boots were made for walkin'") plays—Lorri walks in wearing hip waders- walks down runway, pauses, twirls, and then goes to stage -)
